Posting your work is a sign of appreciation to the patrons/seater/ poser, DON'T sign up if you do not wish to post your work for view/ sale.

Who can take part in "OIC Portrait Day"

- Anyone who loves to draw and have been drawing passionately (You don't have to be an illustrator/ artist)
- A team player, help out to set up tables and chairs and clear stuff after we are done. Please help to keep the area clean.
- Stay for whole session from **2-7pm on Sat.**
- Help by paying your share of the rental of our booth @ MAAD (price range starts from S\$10 depending on nos of participants)
- All proceeds of sale of your drawing goes to the artist.
- Please turn up when you register- We depend on your registering and showing up to conduct the event smoothly.

When you are drawing with us at "OIC Portrait Day"

- We hope you make new friends at OIC
- Be helpful
- Lookout for one another's belonging's
- Please do not use more than 1 chair if you see fellow artist without seats, or use a chair for your tools and materials or bags.
- If you spill any paint clean it up
- Pay your share for booth rental and If you have to leave early- do let the co-ordinator know.

What should I bring?

- Please bring all your own drawing materials and paper.
- A study backing board/ surface to draw on
- namecards (remember to network and socialise :D !!)

Can I bring my kids along?

Sure you can as long as they don't disrupt the activities or disturb other artists.
